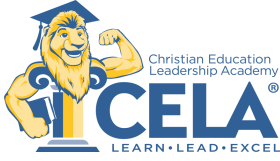

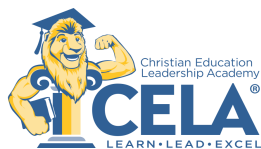

The students in the Mind, Body, Spirit elective did an "All About Me" presentation where they had to write a poem about their favorite thing about themselves, pick their favorite bible verse, and pick out pictures that resemble them.



8th Grade Civics

In Civics class, the 8th graders participated in an act-it-out of the Constitutional Convention of 1787. After learning previously about the failures of the Articles of Confederation, each student (as their historical founding father from different states) was tasked with working together to create a compromise that would "form a more perfect union." They respectfully debated three proposals regarding state representation in Congress, each of which failed to gain a majority vote. Then, Roger Sherman from Connecticut submitted the famous compromise plan that is still how our Congress works today: two houses of Congress, one based on population and the other with equal representation for every state. The 8th graders now have a firm grasp on both why and how our Congress is the way it is today.

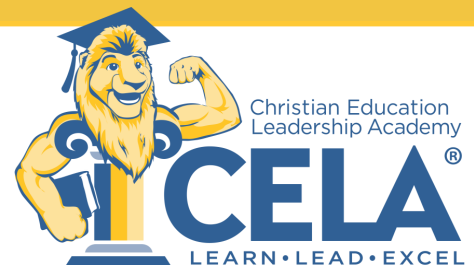
